

Square Knot Assembly

- 1 Place the ribbon behind the invitation leaving the right side of the ribbon slightly longer than the left. Overlap the right side over the top of the left.



- 2 Tie a common knot by looping the right side under the left.



- 3 Pull ends tight vertically to create a "t".



- 4 Holding the center knot in place with your left pointer finger, adjust the bottom ribbon to hold loosely in your left hand as shown.



- 5 Bring the top ribbon over the ribbon in your left hand and loop it through the hole.



- 6 Pull both ends horizontally to tighten and adjust knot as needed. (Tip: Don't pull too tightly or the beauty of the center loop will be lost.)



You're done!
