

Square Knot Assembly

Place the ribbon behind the invitation leaving the right side of the ribbon slightly longer than the left. Overlap the right side over the top of the left.



Tie a common knot by looping the right side under the left.



3 Pull ends tight vertically to create a "t".



4 Holding the center knot in place with your left pointer finger, adjust the bottom ribbon to hold loosely in your left hand as shown.



Bring the top ribbon over the ribbon in your left hand and loop it through the hole.



Pull both ends horizontally to tighten and adjust knot as needed.

(Tip: Don't pull too tightly or the beauty of the center loop will be lost.)
